

# JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Code/Title: EUS / NETWORK TECH

#### SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, installs, tests, maintains, and repairs operating systems and software configuration and programming of data communications network(s).

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Ensures that network connections are on line and active within assigned zone.
- 2. Troubleshoots and resolves network communication problems.
- 3. Operates and tests network software and hardware configurations.
- 4. Performs preventive network hardware and software maintenance.
- 5. Maintains current and accurate documentation of existing and future network infrastructure in assigned zone.
- 6. Assists in design and implementation of network projects in assigned zone.
- 7. May maintain inventory levels and records of equipment and material for maintenance and installation projects.
- 8. May oversee work and performance of subcontractors engaged in projects in assigned zone in order to ensure compliance with work orders.
- 9. Maintains currency of knowledge with respect to relevant state-of-the-art technology, equipment, and/or systems.
- 10. Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

## MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:

High school diploma or GED with 1 to 3 years experience directly related to the duties and responsibilities specified.

# KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Knowledge of current technological developments/trends in area of expertise.
- Ability to maintain and troubleshoot computer network hardware, software, and peripherals.
- Knowledge of network connections and facilities.
- Knowledge of a range of computer networking systems and protocols.
- Knowledge of computer network infrastructure requirements.
- Records maintenance skills.

## **DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:**

Position requires: a) Maintaining, troubleshooting and repairing network communications; b) Operating and testing network configurations; c) Assisting in design

and implementation of network projects, and d) Maintaining accurate documentation of network infrastructure.

# **WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL EFFORT:**
